


Apache County Evacuation Routes

The roads indicated on this map are those highways that would comprise the designated evacuation routes for Apache County residents during a declared disaster.

It is likely that some routes may be blocked or heavily congested during a response to the event.

If a disaster or catastrophic event should occur in Apache County, specific routes will be identified based on the **nature of the event, location of event, number of residents impacted, volume of emergency vehicles entering the area and most importantly the safety of the public and emergency responders.**

All notifications related to any declared evacuation and the designation of specific routes will be posted on the **Apache County website, the Apache County Emergency Management Facebook page, the Northeast Arizona Public Information System www.311info.net, broadcast over local radio stations and delivered to all media outlets.** Additionally, maps and notices will be posted on local bulletin boards around each community that is impacted
